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**Judul : Analisis Kualitatif Rekam Medis Dengan 6 Komponen Review
Pada Diagnosa Apendisitis Akut Di Rsu Imelda Pekerja
Indonesia Tahun 2025**

ABSTRAK

Rekam medis merupakan dokumen penting yang mencerminkan mutu pelayanan kesehatan sekaligus berfungsi sebagai bukti hukum, sehingga pencatatannya harus lengkap, akurat, dan konsisten. Inkonsistensi dapat menimbulkan risiko terhadap keselamatan pasien serta potensi tuntutan hukum. Penelitian ini bertujuan menilai mutu rekam medis pasien Apendisitis Akut melalui analisis kualitatif menggunakan enam komponen review di RSUD Imelda Pekerja Indonesia tahun 2025. Penelitian menggunakan desain *mixed method* dengan pendekatan *sequential explanatory*. Sampel penelitian sebanyak 11 rekam medis yang dipilih dari 106 kasus Apendisitis Akut. Data diperoleh melalui telaah dokumen rekam medis dan wawancara mendalam, kemudian dianalisis berdasarkan enam komponen review, yaitu identifikasi pasien, laporan penting, autentikasi, kelengkapan pencatatan, konsistensi data, dan potensi tuntutan hukum. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan masih terdapat ketidakkonsistenan pada beberapa komponen, terutama identifikasi pasien, autentikasi, dan konsistensi pernyataan diagnostik, meskipun tidak ditemukan *compensable event* pada potensi tuntutan hukum. Disimpulkan bahwa mutu rekam medis pasien Apendisitis Akut di RSUD Imelda Pekerja Indonesia tahun 2025 belum sepenuhnya memenuhi standar, sehingga perlu perbaikan dalam aspek kelengkapan, konsistensi, dan pencatatan identifikasi untuk meningkatkan mutu serta mencegah risiko hukum di masa depan.

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**Title : Qualitative Analysis Of Medical Records Using Six Review
Components In Acute Appendicitis Diagnosis At Imelda
Workers' General Hospital, 2025**

ABSTRACT

Medical records are essential documents that reflect the quality of healthcare services while also serving as legal evidence; therefore, they must be recorded in a complete, accurate, and consistent manner. Inconsistencies may pose risks to patient safety as well as potential legal claims. This study aimed to assess the quality of medical records of Acute Appendicitis patients through qualitative analysis using six review components at Imelda Workers' General Hospital in 2025. This research employed a mixed-method design with a sequential explanatory approach. The study sample consisted of 11 medical records selected from 106 Acute Appendicitis cases. Data were obtained through document review and in-depth interviews, then analyzed based on six review components: patient identification, essential reports, authentication, completeness of documentation, data consistency, and potential legal claims. The results indicate inconsistencies in several components, particularly in patient identification, authentication, and consistency of diagnostic statements, although no compensable event was found in terms of potential legal claims. It is concluded that the quality of medical records of Acute Appendicitis patients at Imelda Workers' General Hospital in 2025 has not yet fully met the standards. Improvements are required in completeness, consistency, and identification recording to enhance quality and prevent legal risks in the future.
